- LOCAL RULES -

- To aid in preserving the beauty and condition of our golf course, please repair all ball marks, rake bunkers, fill divots with sand and place trash and recyclables in the appropriate receptacles.
- Any ball lost or unplayable within the boundaries of the golf course may be treated as a lateral hazard. Please reference the point where the ball entered the condition to take your drop.
- Where cart paths tie into native areas, all relief may be taken to the nearest point, no closer to the hole, on the fairway side of the path.
- Please keep carts on the path around tees and greens and on par 3s at all times. Observe the 90 degree rule on the remainder of the holes unless otherwise instructed.
- · Spikeless golf shoes are required.
- Thank you for following the pace of play policy outlined by the Starter.

- LIGHTNING POLICY -

If lightning is in the area, a continuous single-pitch siren will sound. All players must return to the clubhouse and take shelter immediately. A high-low pitched siren will signal when you may resume play.

— YARDAGE —

All yardages on tees and sprinkler heads are measured to the center of the green.
